

FP2030 Country Fact Sheet - 2022

● Total Users of Modern Contraception	2.8 M	5.2 M
● Modern Contraceptive Prevalence Rate (mCP)	25.0%	32.8%
● Unmet Need for Modern Contraception (mUN)	22.4%	19.6%
● Demand Satisfied for Modern Contraception (mDS)	52.7%	62.6%


