


Sao Tome and Principe

● Total Users of Modern Contraception	13,000	19,000
● Modern Contraceptive Prevalence Rate (mCP)	29.2%	35.7%
● Unmet Need for Modern Contraception (mUN)	27.1%	23.3%
● Demand Satisfied for Modern Contraception (mDS)	51.8%	60.3%

As a result of modern contraceptive use:


7,200
